Who May Use the Dana Medical Library?

You! As a volunteer faculty member you have electronic access to journals and databases, and book borrowing privileges for the duration of your appointment.

How do I use electronic resources from my office or home?

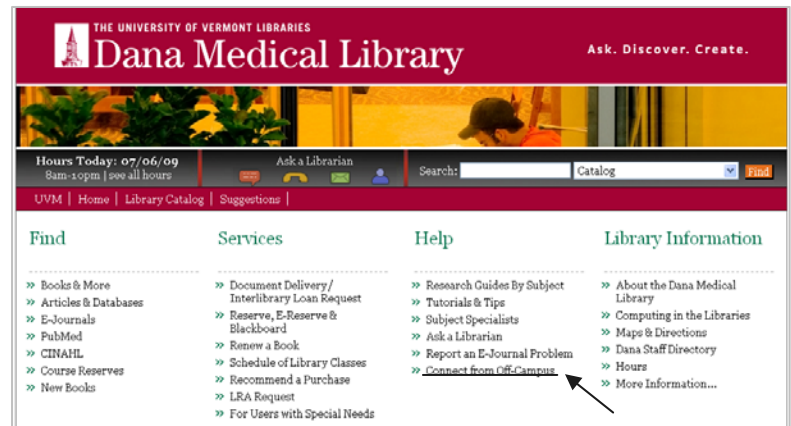
Most library-subscribed electronic journals and databases are available from off UVM campus through the UVM Network via VPN (Virtual Private Network) or EZProxy. You must have completed the faculty appointment paperwork and submitted it through your College of Medicine Department to have access to the UVM network. Access to these resources from off campus can be obtained by clicking on *Connect From Off Campus* under the *Help* heading on the Dana Library web site.

Library Services

Services may be requested in person or via the Dana Library web site. The Library is at your service 24/7 by virtue of its comprehensive electronic resources:

- Request a literature search or clinical emergency articles from experienced staff (Call the Reference Desk at 656-2201 or 656-2200)
- Delivery of print articles owned by Dana (\$5.00 fee applies to all faculty)
- Interlibrary Loan Services (No fee)
- Borrowing privileges with presentation of your UVM ID badge
- Class instruction on a variety of topics including:
 - Help with bibliographies and citations using EndNote
 - E-Journal access help
 - Searching the biomedical literature using PubMed or OVID Medline
 - Other topics of interest to you, for example, RSS feeds, blogs, Loansome Doc (articles from PubMed)
 - See Dana Library Schedule of Library Classes for each semester



The Library Facility

The Dana Medical Library is located on the concourse between the UVM Medical Education Center and the 2nd level of the West Pavilion in Fletcher Allen. Just follow signs to the Medical Education Center and the Dana Medical Library.

Sunday	9:00 a.m. – Midnight

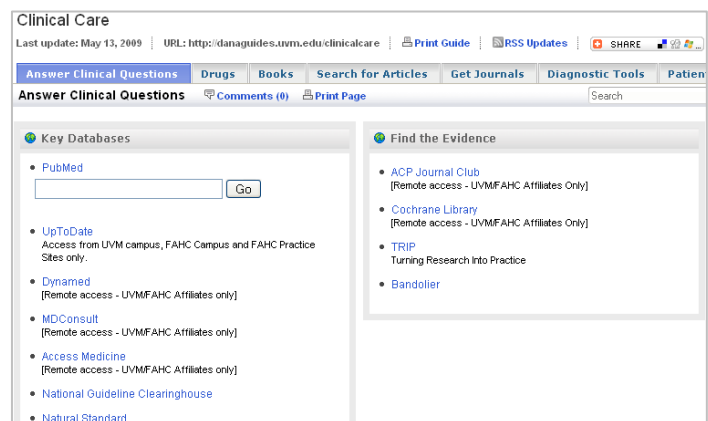


The Library contains over forty computer stations, a computer classroom and small-group study rooms with whiteboards, data ports and wireless access.

Medical Content Resources

- Over 5,000 health sciences journals, most of them available electronically
- Authoritative and evidence-based databases to answer clinical questions:
 - OVID Medline & PubMed Medline, including links to full text articles
 - MDConsult (medical textbooks, clinics and journals)
 - Harrison's Online (frequently updated medicine text)
 - Cochrane Library (evidence-based reviews)
 - ACP Journal Club
 - Natural Standard (complementary and integrative medicine)
 - DynaMed (evidence-based point of care access from anywhere)
 - UpToDate (available only on campus)
 - Micromedex (drug information)
 - Clinical Pharmacology (drug information)

- Over 23,000 books including numerous electronic medical textbooks. The Library includes a consumer health collection and is open for general use by the community.
